Subject: CE Marking of lead-acid batteries

With reference to inquiries and requests for CE marking of lead-acid batteries delivered with Honeywell fire alarm, voice alarm, extinguishing, security and other systems hereby we inform and comment the following in view of current standpoint of European Union Directives:

Currently no European Union Directive covers lead acid batteries for CE marking. European Union law, in principle New Legislative Framework, defines that only products which fall under defined EU directives can and must be CE-marked and have CE declaration of conformity issued by manufacturer or authorized representative. Lead acid batteries do not fall under any a/m EU directive and therefore must not be CE marked and must not get CE declaration of conformity issued.

Lead acid batteries do not fall also under Construction Product Regulation i.e. are not defined as construction products by CPR law and therefore cannot and must not have Declaration of Performance issued and cannot / must not get marked with DoP number.

Fixed fire alarm, voice alarm, extinguishing, security systems, which use lead acid batteries as system component do fall under EU directives and system designer and installer must assure that complete system meets applicable EU directives.

This statement refers in principle to the following lead acid SunBattery batteries:
