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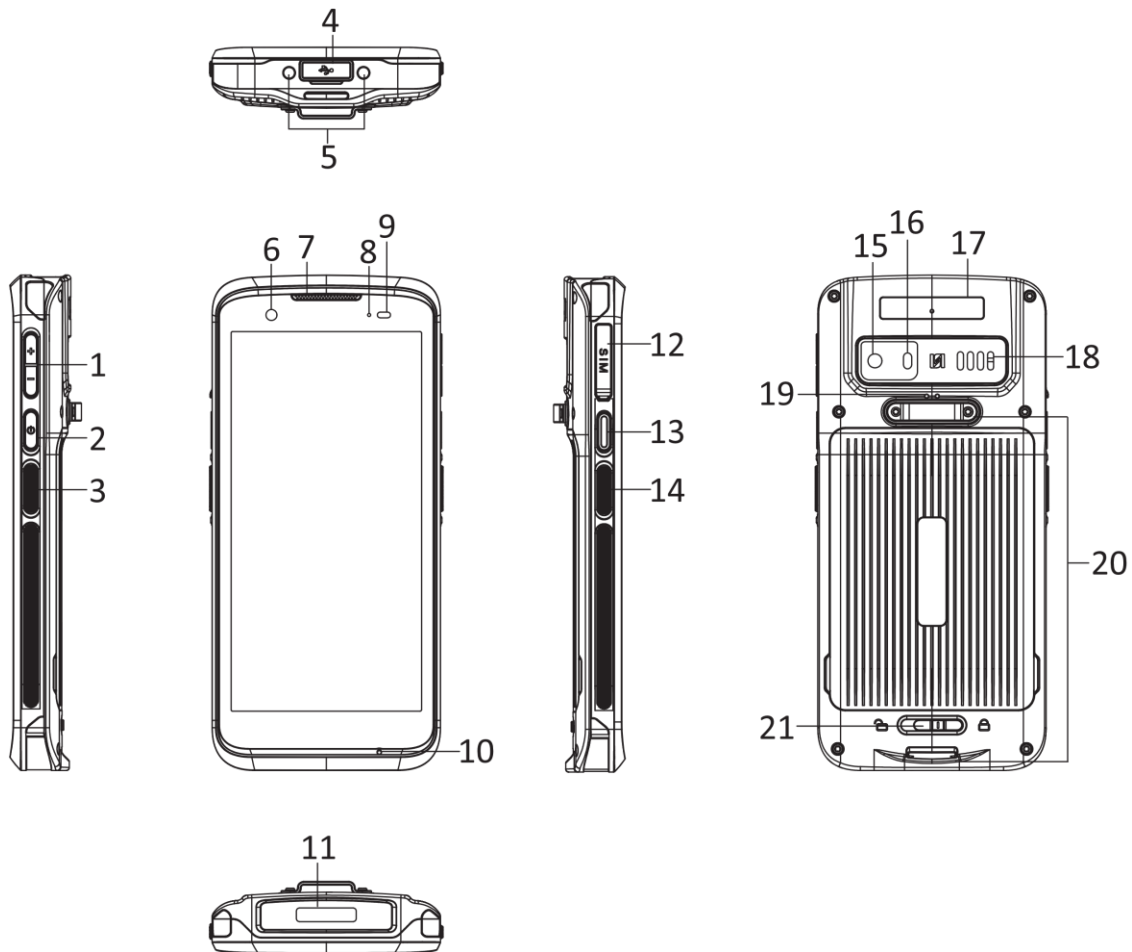
Symbol Conventions

The symbols that may be found in this document are defined as follows.

Symbol	Description
 Note	Provides additional information to emphasize or supplement important points of the main text.
 Caution	Indicates a potentially hazardous situation, which if not avoided, could result in equipment damage, data loss, performance degradation, or unexpected results.
 Danger	Indicates a hazard with a high level of risk, which if not avoided, will result in death or serious injury.



Product Overview



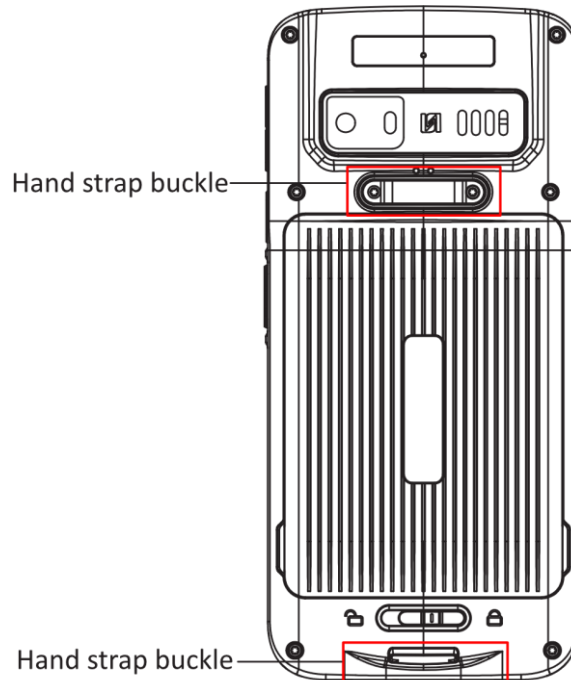
No.	Name	Description
1	Volume button	When the device is on, press it to adjust volume.
2	On/Off button	- When the device is off, hold it to turn the device on. - When the device is on, hold it to turn the device off. - When the device is on, press it to brighten or sleep the screen.
3/14	Scan button	When the device is on, press it and point the scan sensor to the code to scan and get the code information.
4	USB interface	To connect to the USB Type-C cable for charging or data transmission.
5	Charging contact	To connect the base to charge the device.
6	Front camera	For recording or picture capture.

7	Handset	For sound play.
8	Indicator	● Solid red: The device is being charged. ● Solid green: The device is fully charged. ● Flashing red: The device is in low battery.
9	Distance sensor	To perceive distance.
10	Main microphone	For sound collection.
11	Scan sensor	To scan codes.
12	SIM/TF card slot	Built-in SIM/TF card tray for SIM/TF card installation.
13	Reserved button	Reserved.
15	Rear camera	For recording or picture capture.
16	Flash light	To supplement light when using camera.
17	Warning label	To attach the laser warning label.
18	Loudspeaker	For sound play.
19	Sub-microphone	For sound collection.
20	Hand strap buckle	To install the hand strap.
21	Back cover lock	To lock or unlock the back cover.



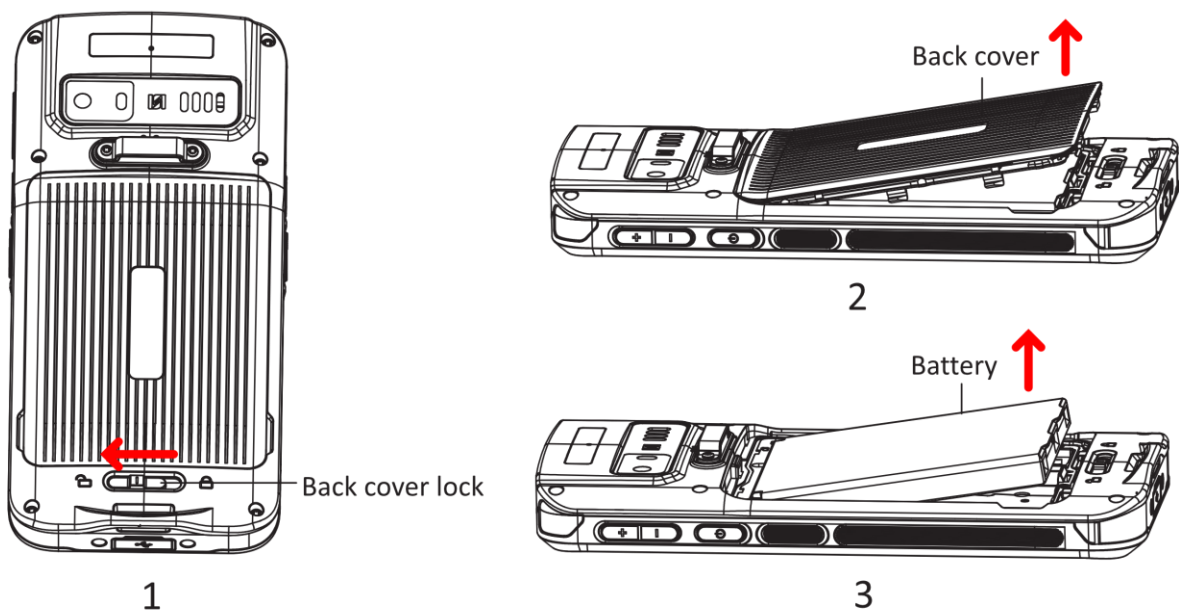
Device Installation

Install Hand Strap

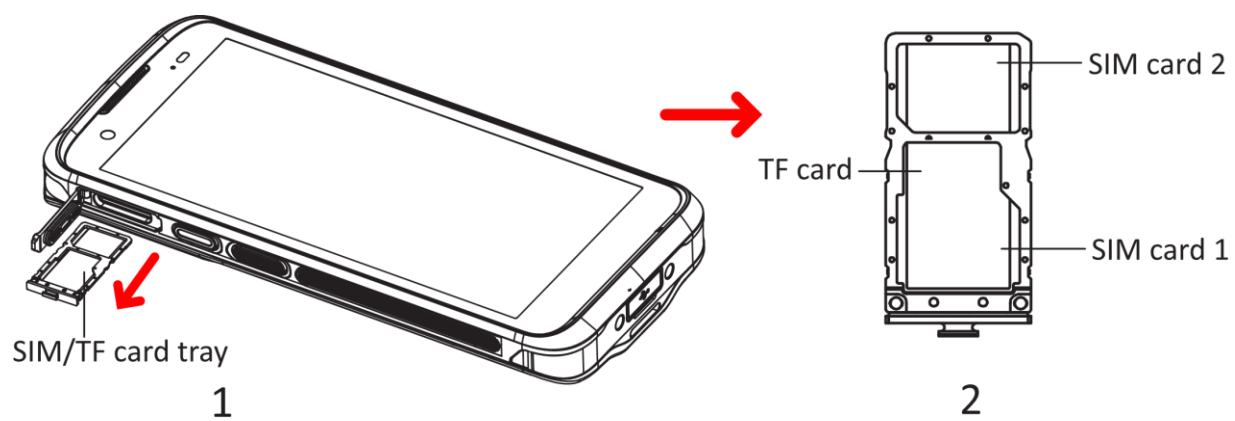


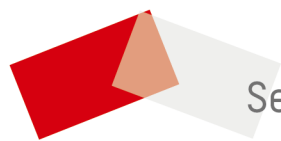
To change the hand strap, lead one end of the strap through the hand strap buckles on the device back cover from bottom to top, and then connect both ends of the strap.
